"Environment and transitions in the face of the global climate-ecological crisis".

1. About the Journal

The CEERI Global Journal is a digital scientific journal aimed at disseminating research papers related to the study area of International Relations. Thus, it aims, from its fundamental bases, to promote scientific research and disseminate knowledge related to the different areas of study of International Relations, seeking to address a contemporary agenda in a presentation updated to our times. To this end, we propose to create an innovative format that incorporates digitalized information, through the use of computer tools and novel ways of publicizing academic content.

CEERI Global Journal accepts articles from specialists in the different areas of International Relations and related sciences, which allows it to have quality content, positioning it among the most recognized journals.

The Journal is open-access and free of charge. It is published biannually in the electronic portal www.ceeriglobal.org, where it can be downloaded in PDF format.

All articles submitted for inclusion in the CEERI Global digital journal must be original and unpublished.

The objectives are the following:

- 1. To publish and disseminate original and updated scholarly articles, essays, book reviews, interviews, updates on topics and research in progress or completed.
- 2. To form an open access and participatory epistemic community of International Relations.
- 3. To promote the dissemination of academic research and studies conducted by a wide range of participants, including students, academics and practitioners.
- 4. To foster the link between experts, students and practitioners in the field of International Relations.

Frequency of publication

The CEERI Global Journal is published twice a year, at the end of each semester.



Open access policy

This journal provides immediate open access to its content on the principle that making research freely available to the public promotes a greater exchange of global knowledge.

Preservation Policy

Materials published in this journal are deposited in the CEERI repository. Automatic backups and remote copies, format adjustments, integrity checks and other activities required to ensure digital preservation are performed through the repository.

Sections of the Magazine

• Editorial

This is an introductory write-up by the journal's Editorial Committee on the most relevant issues in international matters during the semester.

Research

This section is made up of articles submitted by scholars of International Relations. The articles undergo a double-blind evaluation process by experts in the field of International Relations.

Reviews

Reviews of books on any aspect of International Relations.

Reflections

Short essays (no more than 10 pages) by honorary guests addressing current international issues.

• Internal research



This section corresponds to research carried out by the different Research Areas of CEERI. One research per area will be accepted; they must meet the editorial criteria of the journal.

• Multimedia Segment

It consists of the publication of content in multimedia formats, interviews, podcasts, among others, where referents of the academic and professional environment of Argentina and the world participate. Published in virtual format and on CEERI's platforms.

2. Editorial Policy

CEERI Global is a biannual publication of the Center for Strategic Studies in International Relations. It publishes academic articles previously submitted to external and independent peer review in order to reach a level of excellence. The articles refer to a wide range of issues related to security, environment, economy, law, politics, among others. They are evaluated according to their originality, their contribution to the field of International Relations and their theoretical and empirical consistency. Contributions that can be made from disciplinary perspectives other than International Relations are considered, since it is understood that the transformation process the world is currently undergoing requires a transdisciplinary and creative approach.

3. Scope of the Call for Papers

Theme of the third issue: "Environment and transitions in the face of the global climate-ecological crisis".

Climate change and the deepening global ecological crisis, already emerging as the greatest challenges of the 21st century, place the environment as a central field of study in the discipline of International Relations. The Third Edition of CEERI Global is dedicated to analyzing the shaping of global environmental governance as well as the relationship between the environment and the economic system, security and democracy. The focus is on the ecological and energy transitions towards sustainable development models that promote a paradigm shift.

The generation of studies on environmental dilemmas and ways to transit ecologically not only become essential to understand contemporary reality but also encourage commitment to the ecological goals that will mark the immediate future of the planet. To this end, we receive



papers on the main issues and debates that articulate the agenda on the environmental issue and the ways of moving towards a sustainable paradigm within the framework of International Relations studies. For this reason, papers are invited on the following topics:

1. Global environmental governance.

- The construction of a global environmental agenda.
- Origin and internationalization of the environmental movement.
- The environmental agenda in the United Nations system.
- Environmental issues in the academic discourse of International Relations.
- Critical readings of the Global South and the North-South, center-periphery relationship.

2. Economic system and environment.

- Capitalism and the ecological crisis.
- The ecologically unequal exchange in international trade.
- The relationship between extraction, trade and ecological debt.
- Flows of materials, energy and ecological footprint.

3. Global environment and security.

- Climate change and the securitization of the environment on the international agenda.
- Population displacement and climate refugees.
- The geopolitics of climate and natural resources.

4. Environmental democracy.

- Human rights and the environment.
- The global climate justice movement as a horizon for new environmental citizenship.

Format for submission of proposals for research articles

To submit an article to the editorial process of CEERI Global Journal, a proposal with the following characteristics must be submitted:

- The text must be original and unpublished.
- The text must conform to the journal's editorial criteria.
- The text should be submitted in an electronic file in standard Microsoft Word

format (.doc or .docx). This document should not contain the author's personal



• Font: Calibri, 12 pt.

• Line spacing: 1,5.

- Maximum length of the proposal: 1000 words (excluding bibliography).
- The text should contain a proposal for a theoretical-conceptual and/or a methodology framework.
- Language: Spanish, Portuguese or English.
- Bibliographical references.

Along with the proposal, the following information shall be attached in a separate file:

- Title of the article.
- Full name of the author(s) and co-author(s).
- Academic level.
- Institution of affiliation of each one.
- Phone number, including country code and local area code.
- E-mail address.

Acceptance of proposals
